

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES



- Goal 1: Participating students will reach high standards; at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in Math.**
Objective 1.1: Eighty percent (80%) of regularly participating students attending 30 days or more will meet, or exceed standards in Math.
- Goal 2: Participating students will reach high standards; at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in ELA/Writing.**
Objective 2.1: Eighty percent (80%) of regular participating students attending 30 days or more will meet, or exceed standards in English/Language Arts/Writing.
- Goal 3: Participating students will reach high standards; at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in Science.**
Objective 3.1: Eighty percent (80%) of regular participating students attending 30 days or more will meet or exceed standards in Science.
- Goal 4: Participating students will show an improvement in their absences as measured by local assessment.**
Objective 4.1: Eighty percent (80%) of regularly participating students attending 30 days or more will decrease school day absences by at least 4%.
Objective 4.2: Ninety percent (90%) of the students enrolled in the program will attend regularly.
- Goal 5: Participating students will reach high standards in Personal Enrichment/Health & Nutrition.**
Objective 5.1: Eighty percent (80%) of regular participating students attending 30 days or more will demonstrate Health Awareness as measured by Pre-Mid-Post assessments.
- Goal 6: To improve and increase parent-guardian involvement**
Objective 6.1: The parent- guardian of a minimum of eighty percent (80%) of regular participating students attending 30 days or more will achieve GED, ABE, or ESOL points/rates, as measured by school/district records.

STAFF

- Flagler County School District hires qualified staff to work as Site Managers and Activity Leaders. Requirements for employees include college degrees, certifications, first aid, CPR and continuing education. All staff must be in good physical health and submit to fingerprinting and a local, state, and national background checks. Only certified Teachers are used for the 1 hour PBL's.
- The 21st CCLC Grant Manager and/or Supervisor communicates daily with the Site Managers; as well as Teachers and Activity Leaders as needed to ensure a safe, high quality program for students. The Site Managers are responsible for the daily program operation, coordinate enrichment activities for students, develop monthly plans using a variety of themes as well as weekly plans with hands-on activities. The Site Manager will supervise the Activity Leaders, and is the initial parent-guardian contact.
- Certified teachers and / or qualified Activity Leaders supervise the student in small groups during all planned activities. Staff encourage all students to participate in the activities that will meet the social and emotional makeup of the individual child.
- The BES, RES and WES School Principals, FTI Director, Supervisor, Grant Manager, and Site Managers work together to develop, implement, manage, and evaluate the 21st CCLC Program. Comments and / or concerns you may have about the 21st CCLC program should be directed to the Site Manager or Grant Manager.

ELIGIBILITY

All students registered and attending Bunnell, Rymfire, and Wadsworth Elementary Schools are eligible to apply for admission into the 21st CCLC Program. Priority is given to students who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Students in Multi-Tiered System of Supports with Tier 2 or Tier 3 given priority in the Program
- Students earning below a 3 on the FSA
- Students with a PMP, IEP, or AIP Plan
- Students receiving English Language Literacy (ELL) Services
- Students in jeopardy of being retained
- Students recommended by teachers
- Students that do not meet the Annual, Measurable Achievement Objectives

REGISTRATION

Registration forms are available at each site, or by calling 386-447-4345 ext. 1880. This is a 5 day/week program. Daily "Drop-Ins" are not accepted into 21st CCLC. Programs will reach capacity quickly (70 students/site); each site will hold a waitlist for qualifying students.
